STEP 2: Video yourself talking about your favourite children's book.


Which book have you chosen to share with us?

How To Structure Your Video

What to say and what to include...

But feel free to be creative and do your own thing.

- Say HI and welcome us to The Book Nook.
 If English is not your native tongue, say this in your own language. It reminds us that books are to be treasured, wherever they come from or what language they are written in.
- 2. Tell us your first name and show us the book you are going to talk about.
- 3. Tell us HOW you discovered this book. Was it by chance or did a teacher read it to you in class? Did your mum and dad read it to you at bedtime?
- 4. Tell us WHY you love this book so much and want to share it with others. What feelings does it evoke? What memories does it conjure up?

 Does it have an important message to tell that we can all benefit from?
- 5. Finally, read a short extract from the book itself. It will give us a flavour of what the book is about and help us to appreciate why you love it so much.
- 6. End your video by wishing us a happy reading. Again, do this in your own language if English is not your native tongue. It will leave us with a smile on our face.


